

## Planting Moon Campout

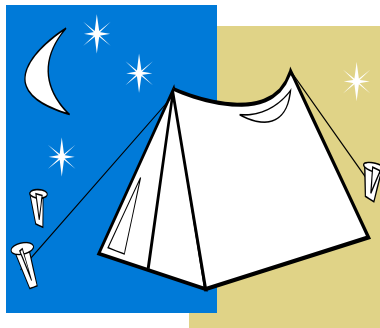

Our parade number will be posted on [www.bigtp.org](http://www.bigtp.org) as soon as we receive it.

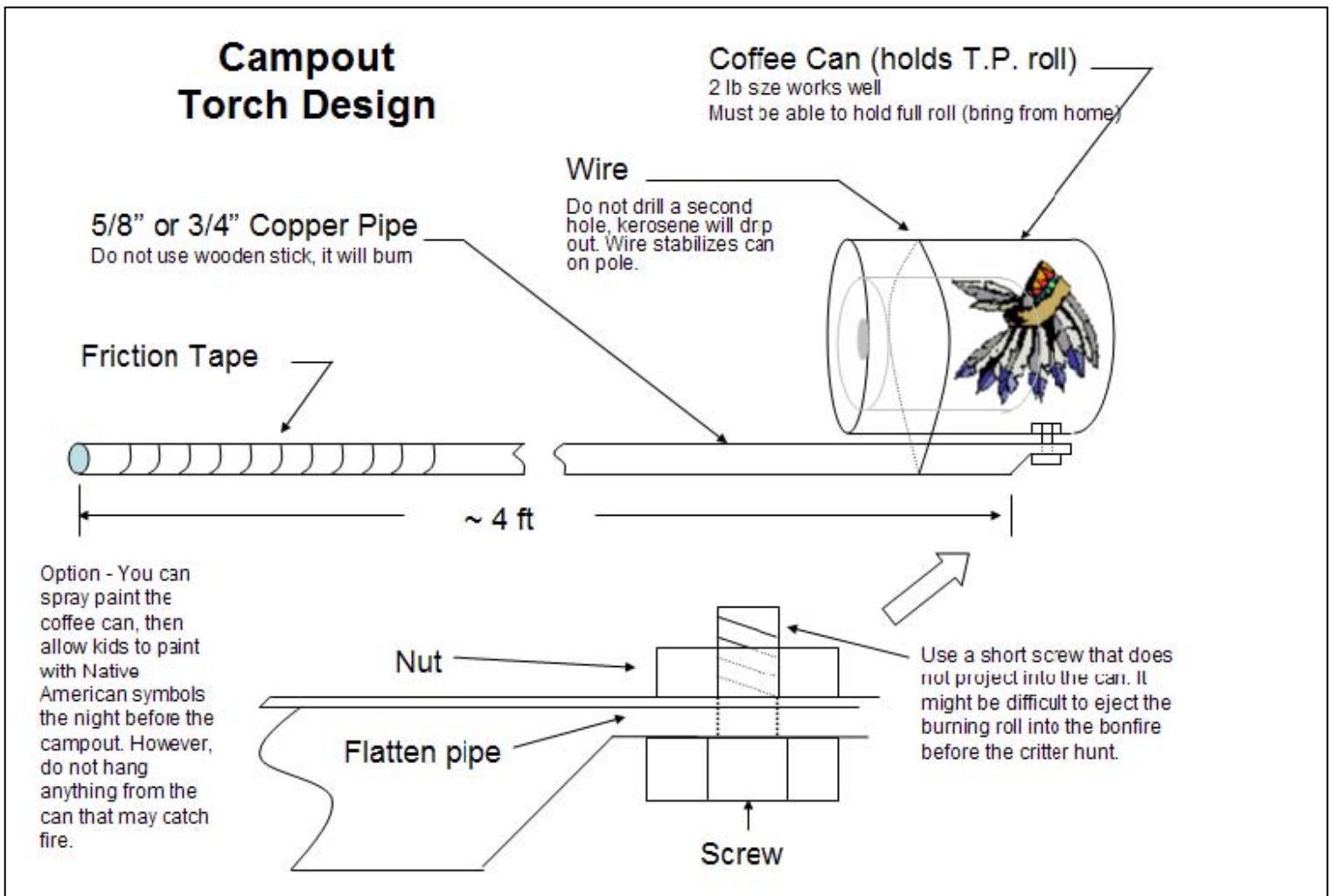
